Program encourages citizens to get vaccinated

YAKIMA COUNTY — The Central Washington Hispanic Chamber of Commerce (CWHCC) and the Greater Yakima Chamber of Commerce (GYCC) are giving out a \$50 to \$100 Visa gift card to local community members who get their vaccine at one of their participating vaccine clinics

before the end of the month — in an effort to increase local vaccination rates and support local business. "Businesses are in recovery mode. We encourage those who are getting vaccinated and receiving gift cards to use them at a local business. This program will not only help us reduce the

boating. Members of the Yakima County Sheriff's Office will be out on our local waters patrolling and watching for boaters who may be impaired or operating in an unsafe manner. Members will also be conducting boat safety

inspection to make sure that everyone has the required and operational life jackets and other required equipment. Washington State laws require that anyone operating a boat is required to be in possession of a Boater's Education Card (for those

born after January 1, 1955). For those operating a personal watercraft, you must be at least 14. For the paddle boarders, you must have a PFD/life jacket and a distress signaling device (whistle). See you all on the water.
