

panoramic view spot in Point Whitehorn Marine Reserve, which features a fully-accessible trail and 54 acres of forest. The trail leads down the bluff to the beach overlooking the Strait of Georgia where visitors can also catch sight of resident great blue heron and bald eagles.

Roughly a mile and a half away from the reserve is the 664-acre Birch Bay State Park which offers campground, playground, picnic tables, boat launch, the Terrell Marsh
