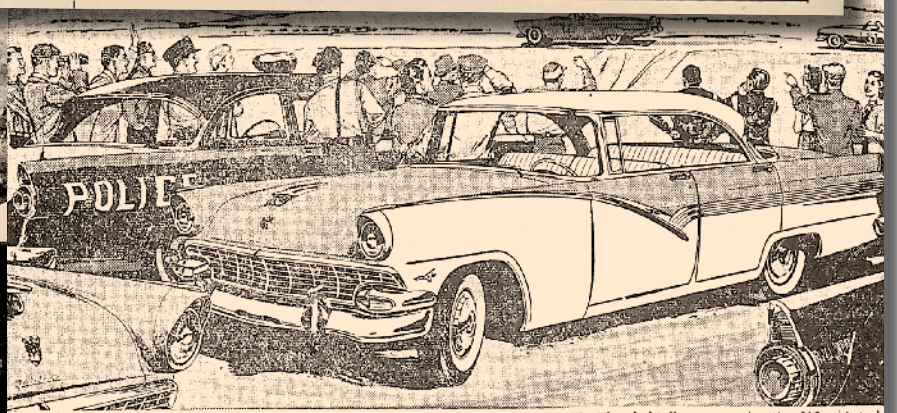

Flying Formations Learned By Shelton Naval Aviation Cadet

Naval Aviation Cadet Geary E. Sallee, son of Mr. and Mrs. W. S. Sallee of Star Route 1, Box 87, Shelton, is undergoing training in formation flying at the Saufley Field Naval Auxiliary Air Station at Pensacola, Fla.

He reported to Saufley Field in June after completing 16 weeks' primary flight training at another field in the Pensacola area.

During his six weeks training he will also receive instruction in combat, night and cross-country flights. He will then commence the gunnery phase of his training at the Barin Field Auxiliary Air Station in Ala.

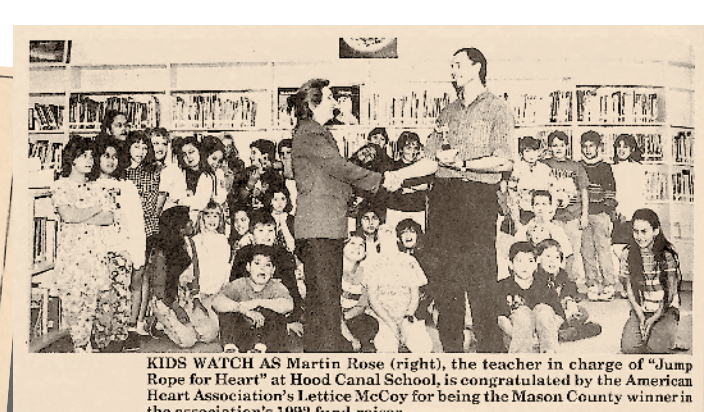
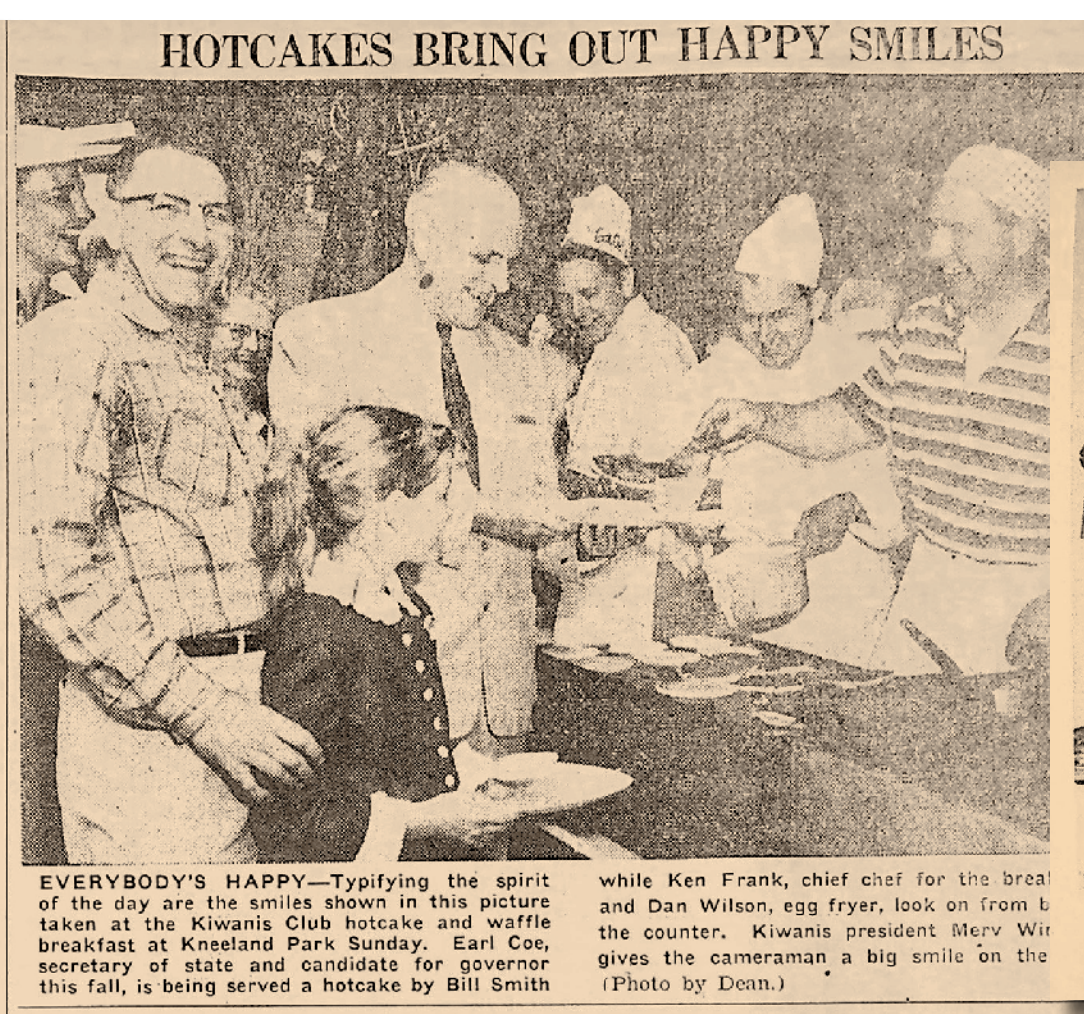

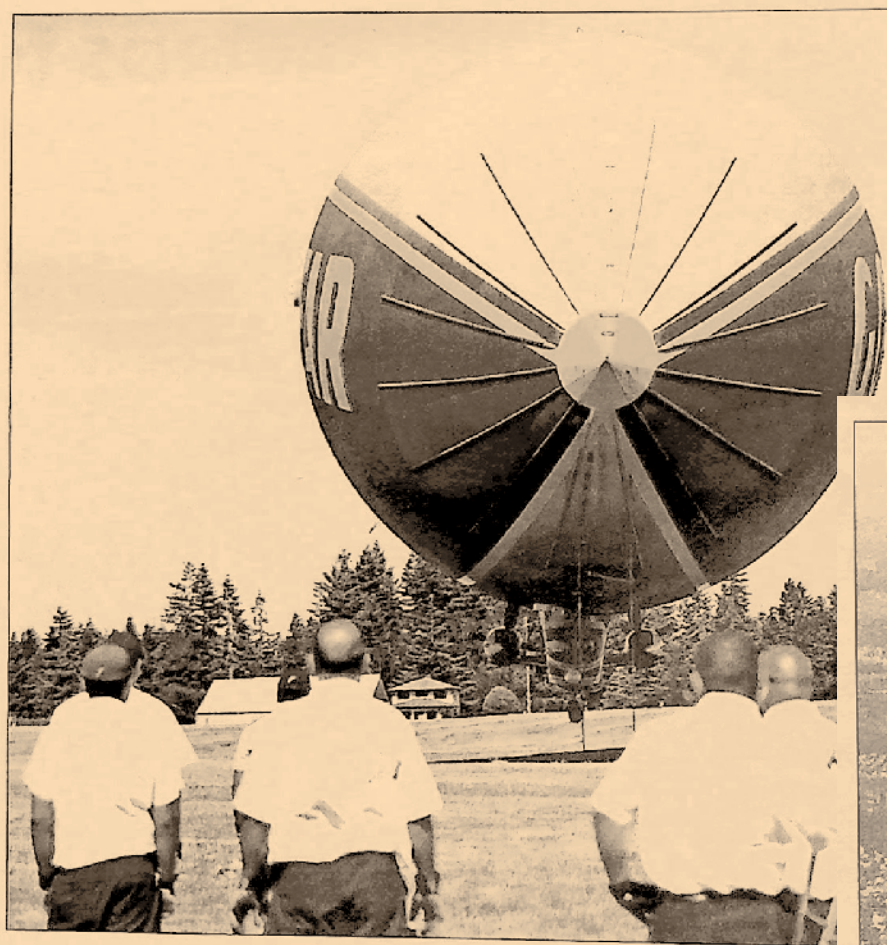
